- 2. Click "My Channel" in the dropdown
- 3. Click "Customize Channel" at the top
- 4. Click "Video Manager" at the top
- 5. Click title link to the video you'd like to select
- 6. Click "Transcriptions" on the left
- 7. If a language is not selected, add a language
- 8. Click "Add" under subtitles section if you'd liked to start from scratch
- 9. Or click on "Published" under subtitles if you'd like to edit pre-made subtitles
 - a. You may also click "Actions" to download pre-made transcriptions
